LENT TALKS AT THE BRIDGE CHAPEL WITH CANON ANDIE BROWN

Pray for the City - The Church and Society: Exile and Restoration Mondays in Lent, 2 – 2.45pm. The dates for these talks are:

22nd February Despair in the City(Lamentations 2:8 – 13)

1st March Hope in the City(Jeremiah 32:1- 15)

8th March Faith in the City(Jeremiah 31:31 – 40)

15th March Flourish in the City(Jeremiah 29:1, 4 – 7, 11 - 14)

22nd March Pray for the City(Lamentations 3:22 – 33)

Each session will begin with a brief act of worship. Canon Brown will share some thoughts, and there will be an opportunity for discussion before we close with prayer. All welcome.

We begin on Tuesday 23rd February and will last for 5 weeks.

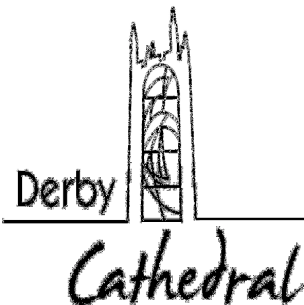
