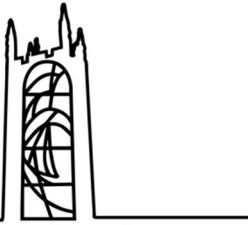

Welcome! At the 10.45 am Cathedral Eucharist on Sunday, look for the welcome stewards in blue sashes, or ask a member of the stewarding team if there's anything you'd like to know. Talk to the clergy after the service and stay on, if you can, for tea or coffee and a chance to meet other people. Ask a steward for a welcome card if you would like to receive emails about the life and work of the Cathedral.

On Tuesday 23rd April, The Sanctuary will open on the refurbished ground floor of the Cathedral Centre, with Christian books, meals and light refreshments, and a wide range of local and ethically-produced gifts. In advance of opening, there will be a special tour for the congregation today following the Cathedral AGM – and if you get up very early on Easter morning, there will be breakfast in The Sanctuary after the Easter Vigil (4.30 am at the Bridge Chapel) and the First Eucharist of Easter (5.00 am at the Cathedral).

THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING (AGM) follows the Cathedral Eucharist this morning, as soon after 12.15 pm as possible in the nave. All elected posts are confirmed at the meeting, the Dean and Chapter speak about the year, and there is the opportunity for questions. A copy of the draft minutes from the 2018 AGM is displayed on the noticeboards. The Cathedral Annual Report booklet includes a summary of the accounts. MUSIC AND READINGS FOR PASSIONTIDE: at 6.00 pm this evening, an opportunity to reflect at the beginning of Holy Week, with the first address by the Cathedral's Holy Week preacher, Canon Dr Christina Baxter CBE. Dr Baxter, formerly the Principal of St John's College Nottingham. In her Holy Week addresses (tonight, at Compline from Monday to Wednesday, on Maundy Thursday evening, and on Good Friday) she will be following the story of the Passion in the Gospel according to St Matthew.

During **HOLY WEEK** on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday at 6.30 pm, there will be an address by Dr Baxter followed by sung **Compline**. The Diocesan Chrism Eucharist is at 11.00 am on Maundy Thursday, 18th April, and the Liturgy of the Last Supper is on Maundy Thursday evening at 6.30 pm. On **Good Friday**, 19th April, the Three Hours at the Cross begins at 12 noon with the Preaching of the Cross, followed by the Liturgy of the Passion from 1.30 pm until 3.00 pm. **Easter Eve**, Saturday 20th April, is a day of quietness and waiting, with Morning Prayer at 8.30 pm and Evening Prayer at 5.15 pm, both in the Bridge Chapel.

EASTER DAY begins at dawn on Sunday 21st April with the **Easter Vigil** in the Bridge Chapel, starting at 4.30 am and moving to the Cathedral for the Kindling of the New Fire and the **First Eucharist of Easter** at 5.00 am. **Breakfast** afterwards is in The Sanctuary. Following breakfast, services are at the normal Sunday times 8.00 am, 9.15 am at the Bridge Chapel, and 10.45 am. Bishop Jan will preside at 5.00 am and 10.45 am, and is the preacher at 10.45 am. Evensong on Easter Day is at the earlier time of 3.00 pm and the preacher is the Dean of Derby.

The next **CATHEDRAL COFFEE MORNING** will be on Tuesday 16th April at 10.30 am in the **Beddoes Room** at the Cathedral (previously notified as being in the Sir Richard Morris Lounge at the Cathedral Centre). Come along for friendly conversation and refreshments.

There will be no **WOOLPACK** meeting on Wednesday 17th April.

MOTHERS' UNION PRAYER GROUP will next meet on Tuesday 23rd April at 10.15 am in the Beddoes Room in the Cathedral.
