On Wednesday 24th April (delayed by a day by building snags), The Sanctuary will open on the refurbished ground floor of the Cathedral Centre, with Bibles, Christian books, meals and light refreshments, and a wide range of local and ethically-produced gifts.

SEASON OF PRAYER: during Eastertide, from now until Pentecost on Sunday 9th June, the Cathedral is marking a Season of Prayer with:

- **EASTER PILGRIM:** Journey through Eastertide with 'Pilgrim Journeys: 40 days of reflections on the Lord's Prayer'. A booklet is available in the Cathedral and the reflections are also available as a smartphone app.
 - **THE LORD'S PRAYER PILGRIM COURSE:** an opportunity to learn more about the Christian faith and to prepare for Confirmation. Adults and young people who would like to be baptised or confirmed at the **Diocesan Confirmation on Saturday 8th June** (4.00 pm) should speak to any of the clergy or come along to the Lord's Prayer Pilgrim Course on Sundays at 4.00 pm in the Beddoes Room, beginning on Sunday 28th April.
 - **REFLECTIONS ON PRAYER:** on Sundays at 6.00 pm, during Choral Evensong, members of the College of Canons will be speaking about a favourite prayer, with prayers from the Bible, prayers by modern and medieval saints, prayers for journeying and stillness. The series begins next Sunday, 28th April, at 6.00 pm, with Canon Peter Walley speaking about St Paul's prayer for wisdom and faith.
 - On **ASCENSION DAY**, Thursday 30th May, there is a Eucharist with hymns at 1.05 pm, and at 6.15 pm we join with St Mary's Church for a joint service of Choral Vespers.
 - For **THY KINGDOM COME**, worldwide prayer from Ascension Day until Pentecost, the Cathedral will host an ecumenical Beacon Event at 6.00 pm on Sunday 9th June.
