News and Notices

ALL SAINTS: the Feast of All Saints, the Cathedral's patronal festival, will be celebrated **today** at the Cathedral Eucharist, together with the Feast of the Cathedral's Hallowing. Following the service everyone is invited to King Edmund's Drinks, a festive variation on the usual refreshments, at Amen Corner in the West End of the Cathedral. King Edmund I (a grandson of Alfred the Great) founded the church of All Saints on this site in 940.

ALL SOULS: This evening at 6pm there will be a Sung Eucharist for All Souls, with commemoration of the departed and music from Duruflé's Requiem.

WEDNESDAY GROUP on 6th November: a chance to learn more and talk about anything to do with the Christian faith, read and discuss the Bible readings for next Sunday, ask questions, meet people and grow in faith. Wednesday evenings, 7pm - 8pm, in the Sanctuary café (across the road from the Cathedral).

The next **COMMUNITY COFFEE MORNING** will be held on **Wednesday 13th November** in the Sir Richard Morris Lounge – down the stairs from the Sanctuary - from 10.30am. All are welcome, come for a chat and a coffee!

DONATIONS from congregational giving were allocated as follows at the October meeting of the Cathedral JPICC (Justice, Peace and the Integrity of Creation Committee): £900 to the Bishop of Derby's Harvest Appeal which will provide materials to build a home in the Diocese of Manicaland, Zimbabwe which was devastated by Cyclone Idai; £350 to BET, the Basotho Educational Trust, for study grants and practical training for students in Lesotho, one of the poorest countries in the world, ravished by the effects of HIV/AIDS; £350 to the Friends of Amasango which supports special needs street children into primary education in Grahamstown South Africa; and £350 to the Derby Churches Night Shelter

Proceeds from tea and coffee after services will go to Alzheimer's UK. Thank you to everyone whose giving has made these donations possible.
